If the tenant lodged their bond online they will be given account details for them to view/update their bond details. When the tenant and agent agree upon an amount to be taken from the bond the agent can claim this amount which will then notify the tenant. Once the tenant has received notified by text or email they can then log onto Bonds Online and agree to this claim-Replacing the signatures on the bond forms.

I've spent a lot of time watching people. Not just in cafes and railway stations but as a job. As a journalist, I've been a professional watcher – a "trained observer" we like to joke – picking up the body language and verbal tics that make us individuals and interesting to others.
