EARE advocates for mobile laundry services in Milingimbi



Milingimbi, an Aboriginal community located on an island off the north coast of Central Arnhem Land, is home to approximately 1,200 people, where many face the challenge of overcrowding. EARE is actively involved in providing tenancy and maintenance services in Milingimbi.

Our routine inspections have revealed that more than 66% of houses lack access to a functional washing machine, leading to significant challenges for families. The absence of this essential amenity results in large piles of dirty laundry, posing risks of vermin infestation and health problems.

In remote communities like Milingimbi, access to laundry services is limited and cost prohibitive. EARE believes that Milingimbi deserves a dedicated laundry service that can bring about positive change in the lives of its residents.

Inspired by the impactful work of Orange Sky in Gapuwiyak and Galiwinku, we are actively advocating for the establishment of a similar service in Milingimbi.
