2025 FEDERAL ELECTION: YOU'RE VOTE COUNTS

Australians are heading to the polls May 3, and while elections can sometimes feel distant, focused on the big cities - the outcomes have a real impact here in East Arnhem Land.

Over the past year, many in our community have felt the pressure of rising living costs. From groceries to rent, everything feels that little bit harder - and across the country, housing is one of the biggest concerns. That's especially true for towns like Nhulunbuy, where rental availability and affordability are real challenges.

But there's reason for hope:

The Federal Government has committed \$4 billion to improving housing in remote NT communities. This funding is aimed at building new homes, delivering essential maintenance, and improving living conditions in the long term.

So why vote?

Because every time our community shows up at the polls, we send a powerful message: we matter. We need more housing options, better support for renters, and real solutions to the rising cost of living.

No matter who you vote for, having your say means standing up for the future of your town.



This month, our team partnered with a family in Yirrkala. The family showed great enthusiasm, eagerly preparing for cleaning day. By 8 AM, they were ready and working alongside our team, making the day a powerful example of the positive outcomes possible through community collaboration.
